

When You Find A Lost Dog

- 1. If you find a beagle that has a Colorado Beagle Rescue tag, immediately call CBR at 303-464-9403. This is a voice mail number, so leave a message that includes all of the following information:
 - Your name, address, and phone number.
 - Explain where the dog was found and when?
 - From the dog's CBR tag, give the dog's name, rescue number, and owner's phone number which all appear on the front of the tag.
 - Indicate whether you can keep the dog until the owner can pick up the dog.
- 2. If you find a dog who does not have a Colorado Beagle Rescue tag or any identification tag:
 - Call the local shelter and outlying shelters.
 - Check with the local veterinarian and the neighborhood mailman and paperboy.
 - Look around the groin (inner thigh) area of the dog for any tattoos. Call a local shelter or veterinarian, and they should be able to give you the phone number of the tattoo registry.
 - Take the dog to a local vet or shelter, where they can scan the dog for a microchip.
 - Post signs at intersections around the neighborhood and in the local supermarket.
 - Place a 'Dogs Found' ad in the lost and found section of the newspaper and also check the ads for lost dogs. (It is FREE to place a found ad in the Denver papers and many other newspapers.)
 - Call the Denver Dumb Friends League at 303-696-4941, and ask them to add this dog to their database of lost dogs.
 - If anyone calls about the dog, ask the person to identify the dog by indicating marks on the dog, the type of collar the dog is wearing, and the dog's name.
